Doulos Guidelines

These guidelines are in place in order to protect you and others. These guidelines must be abided by in order protect the witness of the “Doulos Program” and the ministry of Youth Development, Inc.

- ◆ No pursuing of romantic relationships.
 - Let this be a time specifically set aside for the Lord. Don't get distracted from what God wants to do in and through you!
- ◆ No IPOD's, CD, MP3, DVD, or PSP players.
 - Our desire in this is that each individual involved in the “Doulos Program” would use this time to be quiet before the Lord and know that He is God.
- ◆ No pranks on campers; Any pranks on each other or staff must go through Doulos Leadership.
 - Pranks should not become a distraction nor should this privilege be abused.
- ◆ No food fights.
 - Our kitchen staff and the Doulos, etc., work hard to prepare the meals that are served at the Lodge and we want to respect that! Most importantly we desire to be good stewards of all that the Lord has given us!
- ◆ Respect the facility.
 - After a group leaves the Doulos are responsible for the cleaning and maintaining of the Lodge before and during each group's stay at the Lodge. We desire excellence in the appearance of the facility to the glory of God.
- ◆ No guys in girls' bunk house; no girls in guys' bunk house.
- ◆ Do not go on a walks alone with the opposite sex, nor should two individuals of the opposite sex be in a room alone with the door closed.
 - We want to protect the “Doulos Program” and this ministry against sexual immorality. God's Word calls us to seek to be above reproach and blameless in all that we do and say.
- ◆ Although we will at times be with those who are at the Lodge for camp the sole focus and purpose in this is ministry.
 - We desire to not be a distraction to the campers nor the vision or focus of the ministry of Head Waters Lodge.
- ◆ Be early—ten minutes before you are suppose to be at any given activity such as the kitchen, Bible Studies, etc...
 - When an individual is late, or knows that he or she is going to be late, but doesn't call ahead of time to let an individual or employer know that he/she is going to be late, it demonstrates an attitude of carelessness and can affect ones witness. We want to strive to show ourselves to be responsible and trustworthy.
- ◆ Let a Doulos Leader know where you are going before you go somewhere. Never should a Doulos participant be in a vehicle with a staff member prior to the approval of a Doulos Leader.
 - Neither the “Doulos Program” nor those leaders involved want to be found negligent, we are responsible for you!
- ◆ No riding the ATV's or driving ministry vehicles.
- ◆ Lights out is at 10:30pm, each individual must be in his/her bunkhouse at this time unless there is a special outing, a meeting, or otherwise stated by a Doulos leader.
- ◆ Each person must respect those individual's in his/her bunkhouse and the property of the campers, staff, and those participating in the “Doulos Program”,
- ◆ Each individual is responsible for the cleanliness of his/her area of the bunkhouse. Each Bunkhouse must be cleaned and swept every morning before the day begins. One man said, “Before we fix the door at the church we must first fix the door that is falling off at our own home.”

By signing below I am making a covenant unto the Lord and to those around me to abide by the given guidelines above and any other guidelines given by a Doulos Leader. I understand that my not abiding by these guidelines carry consequences and may result in my being dismissed from the “Doulos Program”.
